The Arlington Conservation Councils emphasis on native flowering plants / native shrubs and the emphasis on management and germination of the native Post Oak and Black Jack Oak Tree in www.ThePostOaks.Org gives the City of Arlington, Texas and beyond the rare opportunity for these two groups of knowledge to come together to create the first native aesthetic arrangement of native old growth trees, native small flowering trees, native flowering plants / native shrubs and native grasses.

It is summarized that this native plant(s) arrangement has never been *put* together in the *Southern* Cross Timbers, since the Anglo settlements, large enough to take hold in our ecosystem culture.
